


PK8™



For many years, The PK8™ existed only as a prototype in the home of Hanne Kjærholm, the wife of Poul Kjærholm. The PK8 was put into production in close collaboration with Hanne Kjærholm and introduced to the public in connection with the 2007 exhibition about Poul Kjærholm, "The furniture architect", at Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, north of Copenhagen. The special form of the chair, with its composition of sinuous curves resembles Kjærholm's cantilevered chair from 1953, but the three legs, which shape compliments the seating element, give the chair an outstanding expression of its own. The chair is well suited as a dining chair together with the PK58™ table.



POUL KJÆRHOLM 1929-1980

Poul Kjærholm was a trained carpenter and continued his studies at the Danish School of Arts and Crafts. He had a particular interest in different construction materials; especially steel which he considered a natural material with the same artistic fineness as other natural materials. Kjærholm was first employed at Fritz Hansen for about a year, where he designed a number of noteworthy chair prototypes.

In 1955 Poul Kjærholm initiated his collaboration with manufacturer Ejvind Kold Christensen, which lasted until Poul Kjærholm's death in 1980. In 1982, Fritz Hansen took over "The Kjærholm Collection", developed from 1951 to 1967, designs, which are logical to the minute detail with an aura of exclusivity.

DESCRIPTION

Chair designed by Poul Kjærholm, manufactured by Fritz Hansen.

PK8™ consists of a base with three legs and a seat shell in dyed and lacquered PC/ABS plastic. The base is manufactured in anodised, satin brushed aluminium. Base and seat shell are assembled using three screws.

The chair comes in black, white, grey and red with front upholstery.

UPHOLSTERY

The upholstery is available in selected colours in the fabrics: Divina and Divina Melange and in the leather qualities: Classic, Rustic, Natural, White, Optical white, Elegance and Sense.

ENVIRONMENT & TESTS

The chair can be completely disassembled into parts to be recycled or incinerated.

WARRANTY

Standard goods have warranty for five years against manufacturing defects (i.e. materials and design). The warranty does not cover leather and other fabrics ordered as customers own or special material as well as products manufactured according to customer specifications. Normal wear and tear and damage of covers are not covered by the warranty. The warranty for wicker and lamps is 2 years.

EXTENDED LIMITED WARRANTY



Fritz Hansen offers an extended limited warranty if you register your PK8™ chair online at fritzhanzen.com/MY-REPUBLIC.
